This role involves planning and delivering recreational, social, and educational activities that promote intergenerational engagement and community building.

- Offsite venues as required

Key Duties and Responsibilities

1. Research, plan and implement culturally appropriate activities for seniors.
2. Assist in developing and coordinating summer programming.
3. Supervise participants and ensure a safe, inclusive environment.
4. Support intergenerational cultural/artistic activities and events.
5. Assist with special event planning and execution.
6. Develop social media content and engagement strategies (e.g., Instagram campaigns).
7. Maintain records, complete reports, and perform administrative tasks.
8. Other duties as assigned.

- Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or protected refugee entitled to work in Canada.
